<sup>KJV</sup> Titus 1:10 For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:

<sup>KJV</sup> Titus 1:11 Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.

<sup>KJV</sup> Romans 3:14 Whose mouth *is* full of cursing and bitterness:

<sup>KJV</sup> Proverbs 29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise *man* keepeth it in till afterwards.

<sup>KJV</sup> Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.

<sup>KJV</sup> James 1:19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:

<sup>KJV</sup> Proverbs 13:3 He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: *but* he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

<sup>KJV</sup> 2 Timothy 2:23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

<sup>KJV</sup> Titus 3:9 But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

<sup>KJV</sup> 1 Timothy 1:6 From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;

<sup>KJV</sup> 1 Timothy 1:7 Desiring to be teachers of the law; understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm.

<sup>KJV</sup> James 4:12 There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

<sup>KJV</sup> Romans 3:13 Their throat *is* an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps *is* under their lips:

<sup>KJV</sup> Romans 3:12 They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

<sup>KJV</sup> James 3:6 And the tongue *is* a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

<sup>KJV</sup> James 3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; *it is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

<sup>KJV</sup> James 3:10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

<sup>KJV</sup> 2 Timothy 2:16 But shun profane *and* vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

<sup>KJA</sup> Sirach 5:13 Honour and shame is in talk: and the tongue of man is his fall.

<sup>KJA</sup> Sirach 20:7 A wise man will hold his tongue till he see opportunity: but a babbler and a fool will regard no time.
